2020 Dalemain World Marmalade Awards & Festival in Japan Marmalade Entry Details [Homemade Category]


Requirements

≪Conditions for Makers≫

- Commercial marmalade producers cannot make an entry into homemade category. Can be either an individual or group.
- Make marmalades through the open pan method.
- Those involved with sponsorship, support and judging cannot enter.

≪Marmalade Requirements≫

- Must contain citrus fruits, and citrus peels must be visible.
- The volume of jar has to be between 110g and 450g.
- Use sterilised jars (new jars are highly recommended), deaerate and sterilise jars after filling marmalade.
- Not including dairy products.
- Fill marmalade to higher level than jar shoulder.



≪Others≫

- There is no limit on the number of entries. You can enter as many categories as you want, but do not enter the same marmalade into multiple categories.
- Entries may be displayed throughout the festival, and pictures of entries may be used for promotional purposes.

Categories

Choose a category for marmalade entry (If you are male and made one citrus marmalade, you have to enter either "One Citrus Marmalade" category or Men's Marmalade" category)

Category	Details
One Citrus Marmalade	Use one kind of citrus
Multiple Citruses Marmalade	Use multiple citruses
Mixed Marmalade	Use citrus and other ingredients
Children's Marmalade	For those under 15 years old (before high school). Help from adults is acceptable.
High School Students' Marmalade	For those at high school.
Senior Marmalade	For those 75 years old and over.
Men's Marmalade	For men.
Family Marmalade	For family-makers.
Homemade Citrus Marmalade	Using citrus that you grew at home or your farm.
Ehime Citrus Marmalade	Using citrus from Ehime.
Black Marmalade	Black(ish)-coloured marmalade. (Collaboration with Black Shopping Street in Yawatahama)
Savoury Food Marmalade	To serve with fish.

^{*}We will select the very best marmalade from all entries while choosing the "Best Category Marmalade" from each category (See "Judging" section below).

How to Enter

- Each entry costs 1500JPY. Send a jar with Entry Form to the "Entry Address" below (All the necessary entry fees must be paid by entrants). XAll the entry fees will be donated.
- Put a label on the side of jar with category name, all ingredients, production month and year.
- Put a label on the bottom of jar with your name and telephone number.
- Jars must be transparent glass. Carefully package jars when sending.
- Please be noted that we don't return entries. While care will be taken to ensure the safe keeping of all entries throughout judging, the organisers and judges cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to entries.

Judging

Judges from UK and Japan will judge based on appearance, aroma, and taste etc.

• Awards

- Best in Show Award (very best of all entries of Homemade Category)
- Best Category Award (best from each category)
- Gold Award (Points:19.5-20)
- Silver Award(Points:18-19)
- Bronze Award (Points:16-17.5)

**Judging points are based on Appearance (2 points), Colour (5 points), Consistency (6 points), and Flavour (7 points).

%There is no limit on the number of Gold/Silver/Bronze awards as they are selected by their points.

Results

Judging results (comments from judges and whether you win awards or not) will be announced to all entrants. Everyone who wins gold or better awards will be contacted via phone and invited to the Awards Presentation Ceremony (All winners are required not to publicise their Award until Awards Presentation Ceremony. We do not cover any expenses such as transportation or hotel).
